##### Operation Christmas Child & WFUMC Foster Giving Tree

**Operation Christmas Child...**100 plastic boxes have been purchased for members to pick up, fill, and return to the church on or before Sunday, November 19<sup>th</sup> for the dedication. Be on the lookout for these in the Fellowship Hall and outside the sanctuary near the Mission Bins. Some are located outside the church office too. Operation Christmas Child is in conjunction with Samaritan's Purse, and your gifts to this ministry will travel to children around the world. If you'd like to participate, but are unsure exactly what to put into the box or have difficulty shopping, then we have volunteers who'll shop and fill a box for you. You can make a check out to WFUMC for \$20.00 and put "Operation Christmas Child" in the memo section; and your box will be filled and dedicated on November 19<sup>th</sup> too!

"WFUMC's Foster Giving Trees" are now up and ready for our church family to select a Barrow county foster child or children to sponsor for Christmas this year. We're bringing back this WFUMC tradition of fulfilling Christmas Wish Lists for Barrow county's children in foster care. This is an opportunity to provide a bit of hope and Christmas spirit to Barrow's young victims of child abuse and neglect. We are adopting/sponsoring sibling groups this year. Since these are sibling groups, we ask that the maximum spent per child be \$100 and the minimum \$50. All gifts will need to be returned to the church office (unwrapped, preferably in black trash bags) and clearly labeled by Sunday, November 29<sup>th</sup>. When selecting a child or children there will be numbered envelopes on the tree with information about the child and the wish list enclosed. Please complete the sign-up sheet beside the tree. The Barrow Dept. of Family & Children's Services social workers will secretly deliver the gifts to foster families during their monthly home-visits in December. Please remember that DFCS has clothing allowances for foster children, so our gift focus should be on wish list items instead of clothing.

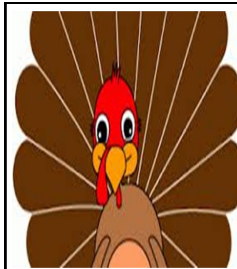

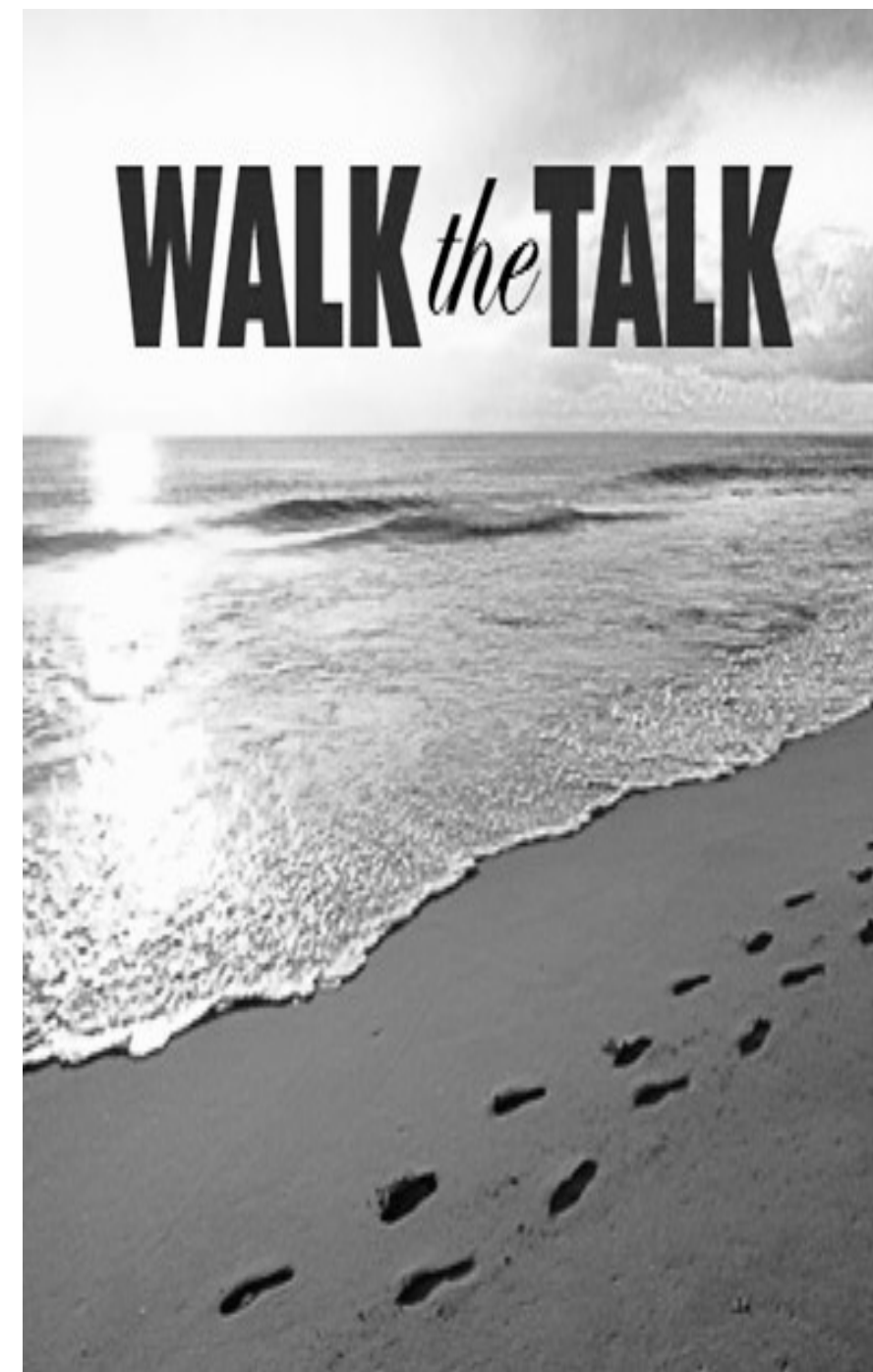
