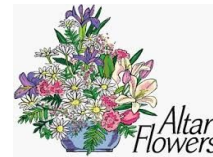

**Barrow Co. Animal Shelter - Donate Pet Food, Adopt a Pet, or Consider Volunteering**

In Genesis 1:26 God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; and let them rule over the fish of the sea and over the birds of the sky and over the cattle and over all the earth, and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." We are also reminded in Isaiah 40:11, "Like a shepherd He will tend His flock, In His arm He will gather the lambs and carry them in His bosom; He will gently lead the nursing ewes."

We might think we own our pets, but the Bible teaches that these are not actually ours. We are only stewards of what God's given us. For this reason, caring for pets in our home or caring for homeless pets in our community's animal shelter is part of being a good steward of God's blessings, and providing for His creatures great and small. There are several ways to help care for homeless pets at Barrow County Animal Control. Your family might consider adopting a pet, or possibly volunteering from time to time to help care for the animals. Additionally, our congregation will be collecting dog and cat food for the month of January to help nourish God's homeless pets. Other items needed are: Bleach, Cat Carriers, Dog Crates, Dish Soap, Paper Towels, Laundry Detergent, Dry Dog Food, Wet Canned Cat Food (Pate ONLY), Dry Cat Food, Hand Sanitizer, Non-Clumping Cat Litter, Blankets/Towels, Kitten/Puppy Milk Replacer, Dog Treats, Dog Leashes (Dollar Tree/Wal-Mart - \$1). 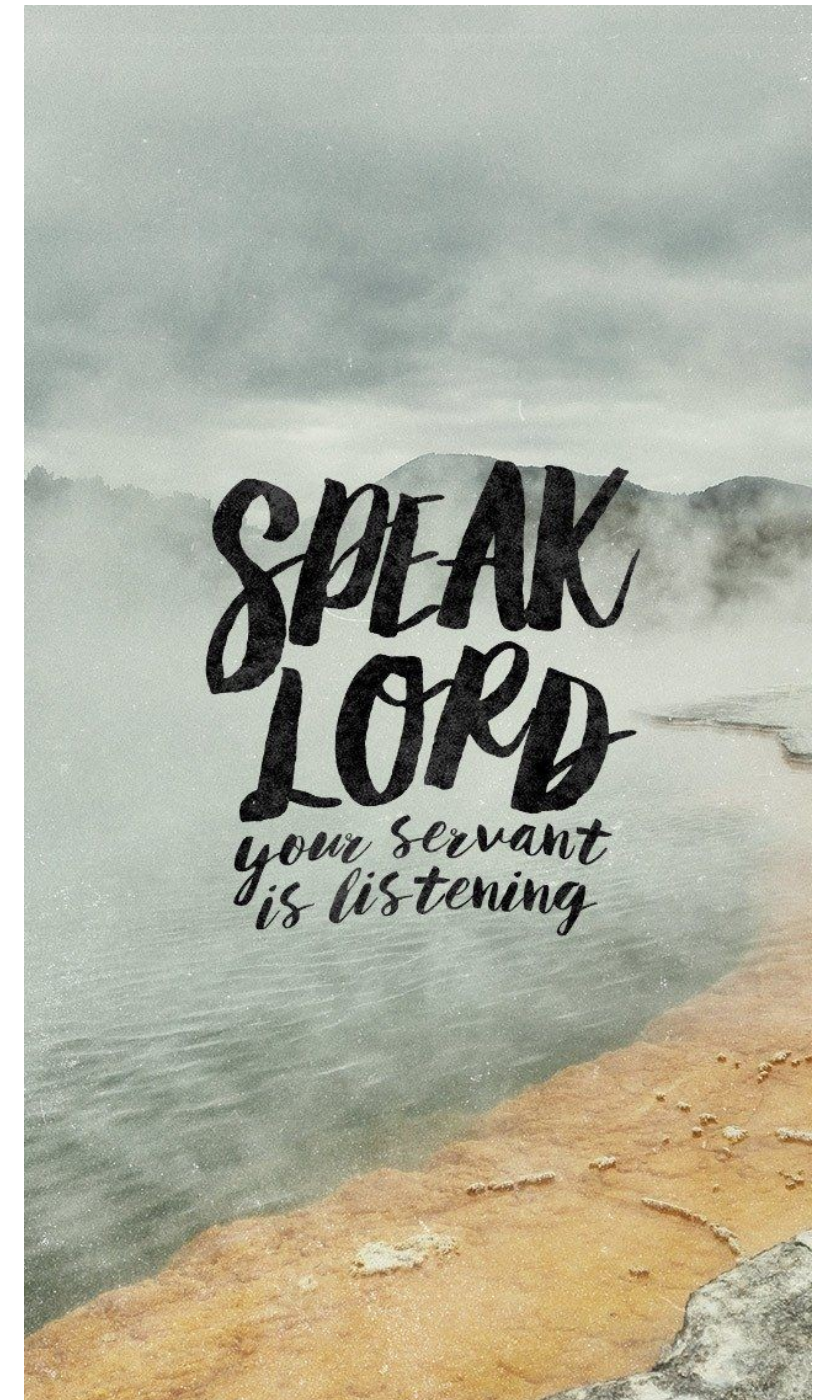
