## Children: Birth-5th Grade

### *Where do I take my child for Sunday school?*

Nurseries for infants and toddlers are located downstairs in the Educational Hall. Birth and Toddlers Room: 109

K2—4 years (children 2 years by September 1): Parents are asked to take their children directly to their classroom. The 2, 3, and 4 year classroom is located downstairs in the Educational Hall. 2-year Room # 112  
3 and 4-year Room #110

If your child is 4 years or younger you can make arrangements for your child to remain in the nursery while you attend the 10:55 or 11:00 service.

Children in K5– 5th grades assemble at 9:45 in the Ladies Memorial Room no. 131. Classrooms for grades K5-5<sup>th</sup> grade are located upstairs in the Educational Hall. Parents are asked to pick children up at 10:50 from the Storytellers Theater Room #209 . upstairs (except for the K5 children and they can be picked up at their classroom).

## 5th Graders, Youth and College

### 6<sup>th</sup> Graders (Begins Fall 2008)

Sixth grade Sunday school is a special year for children as they begin confirmation studies. Through these studies participants learn basic principles of Christian living, Biblical theology, and United Methodist doctrines and beliefs. Field trips and retreats are part of this learning experience. Beginning fall 2008 sixth graders go directly to their classroom at 10:00 a.m.
